

§ 1 Due dates

1. For a given year, the fee is due on January 1.
2. The fee for the ongoing year in which a member joins is due at the beginning of the next month.

§ 2 Regular fees and due dates

1. Ordinary members.
 1. Ordinary members pay a yearly fee of 24 EUR.
 2. Students, apprentices and retirees pay a reduced fee of 12 EUR.
 3. The board can reduce the fee of individual active members to an appropriate amount upon request.
 4. The board may request proof of eligibility for a reduced fee.
2. Supporting members pay a yearly fee of 120 EUR.
3. Honorary members pay no fees.
4. The fee for the ongoing year in which a member joins is the yearly fee divided by twelve, times the remaining amount of full months in that year.
5. Any member can voluntarily pay an increased fee. They can declare any fee above their minimum fee to apply from the next due date on towards the board.

§ 3 Delayed payments

1. Members whose payment is delayed or fails are asked by the board via email to, within two months starting at the due date, pay their fees or agree on a reduced fee per § 2.
2. Members may be charged for costs incurring from failed payments.

§ 4 Means of payment

Membership fees can be paid with one of the following options:

- SEPA direct debit
- Wire transfer
- Credit card
- Cash
